

Recreational Class – Dispersal Procedure



- Dispersal starts at 55 past the hour*
- Takes place from the wooden doors*
- Group coaches give their children their bottle from the boxes and the line children up at the door.
- The dispersal coach stands in the doorway and dismisses children ONE AT A TIME
- A coach must get eye contact and/or a wave before a child is let go to an adult.
- If there is no one there for a child when they reach the front of the line, they wait alongside the coach until they see someone – again they cannot be released until an adult has acknowledged with a wave/eye contact that they are here for that child
- When the end of the line is reached, all remaining children are brought to sit inside the gym – the coach who is registering latecomers for the next class will watch for when their parents come
- At 10 past the hour (when the next class starts on apparatus, any remaining children will be taken to the office and parents will be called.
