Recreational Class — Dispersal Procedure

- Dispersal starts at 55 past the hour*
- Takes place from the wooden doors*



- Group coaches give their children their bottle from the boxes and the line children up at the door.
- The dispersal coach stands in the doorway and dismisses children ONE AT A TIME
- A coach must get eye contact and/or a wave before a child is let go to an adult.
- Is there is no one there for a child when they reach the front of the line, they wait alongside the coach until they see someone again they cannot be released until an adult has acknowledged with a wave/eye contact that they are here for that child
- When the end of the line is reached, all remaining children are brought to sit inside the gym the coach who is registering latecomers for the next class will watch for when their parents come
- At 10 past the hour (when the next class starts on apparatus, any remaining children will be taken to the office and parents will be called.
